
Missing in Woodson Falls

Woodson Falls: 9 Donovan's Way combines the charming atmosphere of a beautiful, sleepy town with a sudden death of a popular writer and the mysterious disappearance of a travel agency owner.

The narrative is structured and direct while beautifully describing the serenity and sense of community of Woodson Falls—a small town in Connecticut; a contrasting aspect to the mystery that Gaby is investigating. With her German Sheprador, Katrina, at her side, Gaby's professionalism and inquisitive nature come with the job as the well-paced plot takes

several twists. The quest for truth alternates with her interaction and friendship with the locals, her past, and her work on another probate case. Clues turn up one by one, connecting to the central question about Mitchell's missing lover and possible suspects in the picture. The story is engaging and I had fun trying to solve the mystery itself. A solid standalone for newcomers to the series and a great sequel for Andrea O'Connor's fans, Woodson Falls: 9 Donovan's Way is an excellent legal mystery with an ending that promises another challenge for Gaby Quinn.

In Woodson Falls: 9 Donovan's Way, Andrea O'Connor seduces readers with a superbly written little gem told in a simple, yet enchanting way that makes it a pleasure to read. There are no complex sub-plots or intrigues in this novella, just an open window into Gaby's life as a lawyer in a small town, with all the small-town goings-on where everybody knows everybody else and talks about it. Andrea O'Connor does not focus solely on the Mitchell case but allows readers to get involved with Gaby's other work and a peek into her budding relationship with

the local policeman. The smooth narrative and natural dialogue will seamlessly transport readers into Gaby's world, sympathizing with her problems, silently urging her to carry on in solving what she suspects is murder. She is not portrayed as a super lawyer or sleuth. She is an ordinary, competent woman coping with life's little ups and downs like everybody else, which makes it easy to relate to her. The ending is not a total surprise, but it will nevertheless leave readers quietly satisfied. **An extremely entertaining read beside a nickering fire.**
